## SHOW REGULATIONS

*Revised April 2012*

### **1 ELIGIBILITY**

- a) Dogs and owners must all be permanent residents of the Channel Islands. All dogs must be registered with The Guernsey Kennel Club or The Kennel Club of Jersey seven days prior to Show date.
- b) The General Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- c) Puppies under six months old on the day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
- d) All puppies entered in breed/AVNPC classes are eligible to compete for Best Puppy in Breed/AVNPC.
- e) Dogs must be entered in breed classes where these are provided, or in Any Variety Not Previously Classified where they are not. Veterans not entered in Breed or AVNPC classes may only compete in Brace or Team (in addition to the Veteran class) and will not be considered for Best of Breed or trophies other than for Veterans.
- f) In counting the number of first places, all firsts in adult breed or AV classes at all Shows, up to and including the fourteenth day prior to the closing date are counted. If entered into a class for which it is ineligible and not withdrawn prior to judging, a dog will be disqualified from any award gained and from the entire Show.
- g) A dog missing any class for which it has been entered will be disqualified from any award gained and from the entire Show.
- h) No dog which has been bred by the scheduled Judge shall be shown.
- i) Docked dogs may be shown.
- j) No dog which is totally blind, totally deaf or cropped (ears) may be shown.
- k) Spayed bitches and castrated dogs may be shown.
- l) Group winners have the right to withdraw from variety classes on signing a declaration provided by the Show Manager. A Group winner withdrawn from variety classes may still compete in Brace or Team and a dog beaten in or missing only a Brace or Team class is still eligible for further competition.
- m) Entry and competition at the Guernsey Kennel Club's Open and Members' Shows for dogs on the Imported Breed Register is limited to Imported Breed Register classes, and only after an Interim Breed Standard has been approved by the committee of the Kennel Club (UK) and published in the Kennel Gazette. Winners may not compete for Group places or Best in Show. Imported Breed Register dogs with an approved Interim Breed Standard may also compete in Matches run by the Guernsey Kennel Club and Companion Dog Shows within the Bailiwick of Guernsey.
- n) No dogs, except Guide Dogs, Hearing and Assistance Dogs and those entered for competition will be allowed on the Show premises, except where an outside venue allows free and unrestricted access to the public.

### **2 CONDUCT IN THE RING**

- a) No person under any pretext whatever other than the Judges, Ring Stewards, Show Manager and the person(s) handling the dogs shall be allowed in the judging ring while judging is taking place, nor shall anyone be allowed in the ring other than when his or her class(es) are being judged. Any infringement may lead to disqualification of the person(s) and dog(s) involved from any award gained and from the entire Show.
- b) Exhibitors shall not wear any official badge or kennel/affix identification when handling dogs in the ring. No rosettes, prize cards or awards shall be worn in the ring, except when challenging for Group or Best in Show, neither shall Island identification be worn. Any infringement may lead to disqualification of the person(s) and dog(s) involved from any award gained and from the entire Show.

- c) No substance which alters the natural colour or texture of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition either before or at the Show. Any other substance used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat. The Show Manager may order the examination of any dog at the Show and, should it be deemed necessary, samples may be taken for further examination or analysis. A Veterinary Surgeon may be called and any expenses incurred will be the responsibility of the owner(s).
- d) The attracting of any exhibit's attention by any method either from the ringside or outside the ring is prohibited. It is the duty of the Judge or Steward noticing such attraction to ensure it ceases.
- e) If any prize winning dog be disqualified, the dog(s) placed next in order of merit by the Judge shall take the higher positions in the prize list provided it/they have been awarded no less than "Very Highly Commended", and the win or wins shall count in every respect as if they had been the original awards.

### **3 SAFETY AND WELFARE**

- a) The General Committee is concerned for the care and safety of all exhibits, but it must be understood the exhibitor/guardian is responsible for any injury, loss or damage to persons, property and other exhibits, caused by themselves, their exhibits or their children. A Guardian's signature is required on all entries submitted by a minor (16 years and under).
- b) All dogs must be on a lead or securely caged/penned and under control at all times within the precincts of the Show.
- c) The Show Manager shall have the power to remove any dog that is not in a fit state for exhibition, or for any other cause. The case must be reported to the General Committee at its next meeting.
- d) In assessing dogs, judges must penalise any features or exaggerations which they consider would be detrimental to the soundness, health or well-being of the dog.
- e) If any dog be formally objected to during the Show for being cropped, tampered with, for blindness or deafness, or for showing any form of contagious or infectious disease, a Veterinary Surgeon will be called to examine the dog and report to the Show Manager, who may then order the removal of the dog. Any expenses incurred may be the responsibility of the owner(s).
- f) All accidents or untoward incidents involving club members or members of the public must be reported to the Show Manager. Full details of the circumstances, including any injuries and action taken, are to be recorded in the Incident Book and the entry signed by the Show Manager, the subject of the incident and up to two witnesses.
- g) Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in vehicles being found in a distressed condition.
- h) Dog fouling and any grooming waste within the precincts of the Show must be removed immediately by the person in charge of the dog.
- i) The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is prohibited.

### **4 COMPLAINTS**

- a) An objection to a dog may be made by any exhibitor or Committee Member of The Guernsey Kennel Club and must be made to the Show Manager on the day or within seven days of the Show. The objection must be in writing to the Show Manager and accompanied by a deposit of £30 (thirty pounds). If the complaint is dismissed, the deposit remains with the Club. The objection must be brought before the General Committee by the Show Manager or Club Secretary within fourteen days of receipt of the complaint. Any person concerned shall have due notice of the meeting and will be sent a copy of the objection. They will be allowed to provide a relevant written statement in reply, which must be received by the Club Secretary in advance of the said meeting. The owner(s) have the right to lodge an Appeal with the Complaints Committee within fourteen days from receipt of the General Committee's decision.

## 5 THE GUERNSEY KENNEL CLUB - CODE OF CONDUCT

The Guernsey Kennel Club (“GKC”) is committed to encouraging a friendly atmosphere at all events, Shows, and Matches - Members must at all times act in a responsible, professional and sporting manner.

As such the membership & participants will adopt and abide by this Code of Conduct (the “Code”):

### **a) Personal Conduct.**

#### **At a Show/Match:**

- Persons must abide by the Show Rules as published and amended from time to time by the GKC.
- Persons must act at all times in a manner which shows sportsmanship.
- Persons must endeavour to be friendly & welcoming at events so as to create a safe and pleasant atmosphere.
- Courtesy and co-operation is to be shown to all Officials, Committee Members and volunteers at all times and particularly during the execution of their duties.
- Abusive, aggressive behaviour or inappropriate language towards anyone at events - including the Judge, other participants, Officials or Committee Members will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- Harassment or bullying in any form be it verbal, written or by any other media including, but not limited to, Facebook, Twitter, email, etc, will not be tolerated.

#### **In and around the ring and at all events where applicable:**

- Whilst competing, competitors will only answer Judge's questions & not initiate conversation.
- Any further communication with the Judge should only take place after the day's judging has been completed, and will be done so in a polite and professional manner.
- Do not distract or interfere with any dog that is being judged in the ring. (Show Rule 2d).
- Do not interfere with any dog that is not in your care.
- Do not pick a dog up by its collar and/or tail at any time inside or outside the ring.
- Rough or harsh treatment of any dog will not be tolerated and could result in disqualification and removal from any event.
- Do not leave titbits in the ring that may affect another dog's performance.
- Mobile phones should be turned off whilst exhibiting and on silent when ringside.
- Cameras should not be used with flash facilities.
- Do not leave dogs unattended for any prolonged period of time. Dogs should never be left unattended on tables.

#### **Children:**

- If you have any children in your care, do not allow them to touch any dog unless you have the permission of the owner/handler for them to do so.
- Be aware of where all children in your care are, and what they are doing at all times.
- Parents/guardians/persons are responsible and accountable for the actions of children under their care.

**b) Conduct when using social media.**

- Remember you are personally responsible for what you post.
- Do not post confidential or libellous information.
- Do not discuss a situation naming or picturing individuals without their permission.
- Check the content is acceptable i.e. would you say this face to face, remember it may be there for many years to come.
- Remember there is no such thing as private social media: search engines turn up posts and pictures many years after they were posted.
- Be sure that what you post today will not come back to haunt you.
- If you make a mistake correct it at the earliest possible time.
- Make sure that what you post is accurate and not based on hearsay, or posted in anger.
- If you feel angry or passionate about a subject, it may be wise to delay posting until you are calm & clear-headed.
- Be respectful of others and their feelings: consider how you would feel if the post was about you.
- Photographs of exhibitors, their dogs, or children should only be posted onto social media, websites, used in Newsletters or any publication etc, with prior permission of the individuals concerned and in the case of children that of parents or guardians.

**c) Procedure for dealing with complaints made under the Code.**

1. All Members of the GKC are entitled to report a situation they consider to be a breach of this Code. Any such report should be submitted in writing (not email), together with a payment of £50.00, to the Secretary of the GKC. In the event that the complaint is found to be upheld, the payment will be returned to the complainant within 14 days of the finding.
2. The Secretary will acknowledge receipt of the complaint within 2 working days where possible.
3. The Code of Conduct Committee, comprising 2 Officials and 3 Members of the General Committee of the GKC, will meet to consider the complaint within 7 days of its receipt by the Secretary.
4. Within 3 working days where possible following this initial meeting, the complainant will be notified, in writing, of the subsequent course of action.
5. If deemed appropriate by the Code of Conduct Committee, the defendant(s) will be notified of the complaint made against them and invited to submit a written response. The timeframe for such response will be dependent upon the nature of the complaint, but should not exceed 14 days unless there are exceptional circumstances, which would be agreed by the Code of Conduct Committee.
6. The Code of Conduct Committee will reconvene to consider any written response and may invite any witnesses as it deems appropriate in order to reach a fully informed decision, following which it will notify the defendant(s) and complainant accordingly, in writing.
7. In the event that the defendant wishes to appeal a decision of the Code of Conduct Committee, then the matter should be referred to The Complaints' Committee which will comprise of independent Non-Members of the General Committee, as elected at AGM. Any such appeal will need to be lodged in writing within 14 days of the Code of Conduct Committee's decision.

Any Member of the Guernsey Kennel Club, or person at a GKC event, found to be in breach of these provisions may receive disciplinary action by the Club and/or be reported to the relevant authorities for legal action, as appropriate.

The GKC reserves the right to remove anyone from a GKC event who fails to act in accordance with this Code.

The Committee of the Guernsey Kennel Club has the right to amend this Code as and when required.

The GKC has a zero tolerance policy.

## **6 GENERAL**

- a) The General Committee reserves the right to add any features to the Show which may be beneficial to the Club.
- b) Show rules may be amended or introduced by the General Committee at any time.



READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING YOUR ENTRY FORM

You must enter at least one breed class. If there is no class for your breed, enter *Any Variety Not Previously Classified* in your Group. **All dogs entered in AVNPC will have a breed class created for them. (This is for all shows moving forward.)**

No separate dog and bitch breed/AVNPC classes are scheduled but they will be created where there are more than two entries not of the same gender.

*On your entry form you must give the **NUMBER AND LETTER** of breed/AVNPC classes.*

Puppy	From 6 to under 12 months of age at the date of the Show.
Junior	From 6 to under 18 months of age at the date of the Show.
Yearling	From 12 to under 24 months of age at the date of the Show.
Novice *	Not having won a first prize. *
Limit *	Not having won more than six first prizes. *
Open	Open to all.
Brace	Two exhibits of the same breed, in same ownership. Must be shown in breed or veteran class.
Team	Three or more exhibits of the same breed, in same ownership. Must be shown in breed or veteran class.
Veteran	Not less than seven years of age at the date of the Show. Need not be entered in breed class.
Breeders' Open	Bred by exhibitor. (Puppy class will be created for puppies.)
Locally Bred	Born in the Channel Islands.
B C Watson	From 6 to under 18 months of age at the date of the Show.
Memorial	Guernsey exhibits only.

*\* Count all firsts at Members', Open & Championship shows in Guernsey, Jersey and the UK, up to and including 4<sup>th</sup> September 2017.*

*A 'first' is a first place in a pre-entered adult breed or AV class.*

*Do not count: wins as puppies, Best of Breed or Group 1, nor wins in Brace, Team or any end-of-show classes.*

*It is your responsibility to ensure your dog is eligible for the classes entered. Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the entire show.*

Winners of AV Junior, Yearling, Novice, Veteran and B C Watson Memorial classes are eligible to challenge for Best Junior, Yearling, Novice and Veteran in Show and the B C Watson Memorial Final respectively.

A puppy beaten only by an adult is eligible to compete for Best Puppy in Group.

If you win **BEST PUPPY IN GROUP** or **BEST IN GROUP** you will *immediately* be asked to sign a form indicating whether or not you intend to withdraw from the Any Variety classes. If you withdraw, you must withdraw from all your entered classes (except Brace or Team). If you continue you must compete in all your entered classes (except Brace or Team). If you continue and are beaten in an AV class or End of Show judging for Junior, Yearling, Novice, Veteran or B C Watson Memorial, you can still take part in Best Puppy/Best in Show BUT the judge will be aware that your dog has been beaten.

## PRIX d'HONNEUR

The system and scale of points have been carefully devised to ensure winners are worthy of the title. Points are awarded at the three Guernsey Open Shows, Spring, Autumn and Winter. All dogs must be Channel Island registered. Sixty points are required to win this award. **Wins as puppies are also counted.**

To ensure a dog will not be imported for the sole purpose of winning the award it must have been resident and registered in the Islands for twelve months. Points will be awarded during this time but a claim cannot be made until this period has elapsed.

### **Owners must keep a record of each dog's wins.**

All claims **MUST** be made in writing giving the following details>

Date of show, show title, judge, dog's name, ring no, class no, place awarded, points won and the running total. Record cards can be purchased from the club.

The claim should be forwarded to the Official Recorders:

They will verify the claim to the Committee's satisfaction, after which a framed certificate with the dog's photograph will be presented. The photograph must measure 5 x 7, which approximates A5, be in colour, with the dog **ALONE** and in a show stand.

Following Committee approval, the owner may use Pd'H after the dog's name when entering all Channel Island, UK and foreign shows, also on all documentation relating to the dog.

A Prix d'Honneur also entitles the dog to lifetime Crufts qualification.
