I thoroughly enjoyed my trip to Guernsey and the weather and hospitality were second to none. The dogs in the four groups I judged, although not prolific, certainly provided me with some lovely specimens and the finals at the end of the show produced several very good line-ups where dogs could have easily changed places and most exhibitors would not have minded.

PASTORAL GROUP

Shetland Sheepdog P. (1) Le Poidevin CONORVEAN BOBBIN JOAN. Compact petite B with nice head though her ears need to settle. Nice spring of rib and good topline, well angulated at rear and moved out confidently. Nicely presented.

O. (1) Le Poidevin SUNDARK SALCE Proved to be the star of the whole show for me as she eventually annexed Grp 1 & BIS. Excellent quality exhibit, well trained, sweetest of heads with good dark eyes, pleasing earset and good neck into well laid shoulders, neat at the elbows and supported on straight boned legs with correct feet. Well ribbed back and held her topline correctly, moved beautifully in all directions. A credit to her owner.

Border Collie PD. (1) Rees & Cullen TONKORY XAMINER Well grown youngster in good condition and sparkling jacket of B/W. Correct length to body with good spring of rib. Dark eyes, good mouth, used ears well. Nicely boned down to tidy feet. Lithe and smooth on the move. BP in Grp.

- PB. (2) Hitchon PATOIS LA PLATTE 10 months in good coat and condition. Showing herself well on the day. Pleasing head and expression, with good mouth. Decent feet and good action, 2. Davies PATOIS CORBETTE
- L. (1) Pearce TONKORY UNFORGETTABLE AT SHALIMAR A lot to like but not moving too well today. Well marked B/W with good legs and feet. Pleasing head with well defined stop and dark eyes. Good topline and well carried tail.
- O. (2) Pearce TONKORY GIN-FIZZ AT SHALIMAR. In excellent coat, clean dark eyes, good in fore-chest and ribcage. Well boned down to correct feet. Moved rather well but tended to be quite close at rear. BOB & Grp 4. 2. Hitchon PATOIS CONCERTO.
- G.S.D. L. Lawrence PENWARTHA INCA WARRIOR Very masculine strong headed male of 16 months. Superb bone and good feet. Strong and powerful at the front with good width and excellent ribbing, but failing somewhat at the rear which was very evident on the move. What a shame.
- O. Lawrence PENWARTHA APACHE ARROW PdH. The most masculine of heads but retaining the lovely soft expression given by good eyes and excellent ear placement. Quality strong bone down to feet which are just beginning to give his age away but he moved well nevertheless and flowed round with adequate drive and controlled power. Lovely front, ribbing and couplings with strong guarters. BOB & Grp 3.
- AVNPC O. (1) Martel VILMORIN SILHOUETTE. Bearded Collie. Very attractive brown with toning eye colour and pleasing expression. Strong in neck and topline and carried herself beautifully on the move with smooth long reaching strides. Nicely boned and with good feet, well coated without excess. Grp2.

Boxer OD (2 - 1) Bayes DOCREMA MY BOY MADGE. Mature and masculine heavily built male of good colour. Good expression, nice neck, heavily boned and tight feet. Excellent topline and tail. Moved easily.

OB (1) Bayes DOCREMA MYSTIC MEG. Head with good expression but not overdone, carried herself well and showed her super outline to perfection. Well boned, excellent feet, compact body and moved in a steady fashion. Nicely marked. BOB and Grp 1.

Dobermann O (2-1) Walker TUWOS FALLON. Good sized solid bitch with excellent length to head and deep muzzle. Excellent mouth, eyes and ears. Well sprung body with super topline. Well boned legs and feet and very good on the move demonstrating good angulation and drive. BOB & Grp 2.

- Pekingese L.(2- 1) 1. Dale & Michel KSARINA SOMETHINGS GOING ON. Heavily coated fawn male with lovely broad head, clear eyes and correct muzzle. Correct pear shaped heavy body with nice bone. Moved well. BOB Grp 3
- O (2-1) 1. Dale & Michel KSARINA TAKE A CHANCE ON GOLD. Darker coloured exhibit with super mask, dark eyes, good width to flat skull. Neat in body and nicely boned. Topline not as good as the other exhibit. Moved readily and typically.
- Pomeranian P. 1) 1. Bennett THELBERN BILL BAILEY. At ten months in good coat and condition. Dark eyes, good bone and neat feet. Decent spring of rib and good tailset. Moving just better in front than at rear. BP & PGI
- LD (1) 1. Schofield RUDOLI BEACHCOMBER. Very chunky in appearance but he is finely built all round and I found him rather short in ribbing. Excellent head properties with good muzzle, correct stop, good eyes and neat ears. Harshly coated. Moved very well.
- LB (2-1) 1. Schofield THELBERN A TOUCH OF CLASS AT RUDOLI. Not quite the glamour of the boys but made up for it in constructional features. Pretty orange sable with dark eyes good ears and perfect mouth. Nicely boned and has good spring and length to ribcage. Excellent tailset and moved beautifully. BOB Grp 4.
- O. (2) 1. Schofield JSY CH. THELBERN STEP IN TIME WITH RUDOL. In excellent quality sable coat with pleasing head, good mouth, and decent spring of rib. Moved very well.
- Papillon O (3-2) 1. Morgan SERENGLADE HOT TODDY. Well coated black/white with lovely fringing and well set on ears. Good eyes and mouth. Well bodied with nice straight bone. Good top line and carried himself well on the move. BOB Grp 2. 2. Morgan TUTYAK BRODIE.
- Chinese Crested (2-I) L Officer SHIPSTONE MR ONE AND ONLY. Darkest of eyes giving sweet expression. Good mouth, decent reach of neck, good deep ribbing. Topline and elbow placement spoil the overall balance, moved OK going away. BOB.
- Japanese Chin P. (1) 1. Curwood NISYROS FRANK CHINATRA. Developing nicely in head and has attractive clear b/w markings. Topline and tail correct and nicely boned down to good feet. A little loose in front but time is on his side. Moved well going away. BOB
- Pug P. (1) 1 Pratt MOUSEKAY KOSTAS. Very well developed in body for one so young and head is already quite expressive, hopefully he will not go over the top. Pleasing eyes. Good ribbing and topline, well curled tail and moved typically with great enthusiasm. BP & PG2.
- O (1) Pratt BARRYANN ENOCH. Pleasing expression with enough wrinkling. Well placed ears. Nicely made in front and good ribbing. Somewhat lazy with his tail on the table but no problems on the floor where he came into his own and moved satisfactorily. BOB.
- AVNPC O (1) 1. Walker ZUMARNIK DELIGHTED FOR PETWALK. Beautifully coated and well presented Maltese with the best of pigmentation to nose and eye rims. Dark eyes, good mouth and well carried head on good neck. Well made all through with excellent shoulders and strength to rear. Really good action and commands attention when in the ring. BAVNPC & Grp 1.

Well sprung in rib, good bone, straight legs under the coat and carries tail well. Moved very well indeed using his angulation to advantage. BP & BOB PGI & Grp 2, BPIS.
- L.(1) 1 Walker PETWALK CODE OF ETHICS. Sister to puppy winner and many of the same comments apply. Similar in coat, great outline, good front and shoulders. Excellent tailset, good bone and feet. Moved well.
- O (2-1) 1. Walker KUTANI CODEBREAKER FOR ZANAMOP. Sire of the two above and has passed on his virtues. Impressive, huge glamorous coat, found him a bit over angulated on the move, but very balanced when stood. Darkest of eyes, good mouth, neck and topline. Well boned and nicely put together. He has probably had an impressive career but look out, his son's about.
- Tibetan Terrier L (1) 1. Martel ARAKI RUMOUR HASIT. Nicely coated B/W b. Typical in head with excellent pigmentation and wide nostrils. Excellent topline and depth to rib. Straight bone with good feet and excellent action both ways. Well carried tail, very stylish on the move and well handled. BOB, Grp 1 and Res BIS.
- O (1) 1. Morgan ARAKI VICE VERSA. Nicely presented B/W d of good size. Maybe a shade lightly boned. Nicely pigmented, dark eyes and strong underjaw. Good topline and correct balance being almost square in outline. Moved well.

- Shih Tzu P. (2-1) 1. Stewart-Smith & Cooper DEBEAUX ALL ABOUT ME. Nicely coated baby with very typical head though mouth a bit extreme, dark pigment and nice neck. Developing nicely in body, moved rather fast but correctly. BP
- O. (5-1) 1. Girard FOREPAWS GIFT OF GOLD. Well coated Gold/W with good head, clear eyes, good mouth and strong chin. Good topline and excellent tailset. Pleasing legs and feet with good angles. Moved beautifully. BOB & Grp 3. 2. De La Cour SANTOSHA RED RAVER. 3. Girard FOREPAWS MIDNIGHT EXPRESS
- Bulldog L. (1) Rousseau SHILOH CLEN MOLLY AT DIMKAS. Quite a strong headed b with slightly overdone over nose wrinkle but otherwise clean and expressive. Neat ears, dark eyes. Really well boned and has pretty straight legs. Well shaped body with good topline and correct spring to rib. Carrying enough weight which made her roll a little but reasonable action. BOB.
- O (1) 1. Rousseau SHILOH HIGH AND MIGHTY AT DIMKAS. Masculine in head with great upturn very small teeth for such powerful jaws. Ears high set. Huge bone to legs and big feet. Well shaped bodily with neat tail. Moved OK but with a degree of reluctance which improved when his lady appeared. AV Utility
