GUNDOG GROUP

Golden Retriever O(1) 1 and BOB Martel's Chalkville Valentino Rosi, 4.5 yr dog and what I call the good, old fashion type, excellent bone and substance, masculine head broad between the ears, strong neck into a good lay of shoulders, well ribbed with a firm level topline and good hind angulation, a sound and true mover but I would have liked to see a little more animation.

SWD O (1) 1 and BOB Trebert's Valentissimo's Ballesteros 2 yr dog, showing lovely balance in profile and with a coat of good texture, good head shape with flat skull and minimal stop, dark eye, neat medium sized ears, tidy elbows and moderate bend of stifle, covers the ground well with total soundness but just a little close when moving away. Was pleased to be able to award him a red card in good competition later in the day.

ESS P (1) BP and PG2

Cox's Petranella Fleur De Lily Avec Tiroen 11mth b and quite a delight! Gave her handler a hard time but much to admire about her, attractive head with long low set ears, clean neck, very balanced with a good length of leg, keeps a level topline on the move and covered the ground freely and easily once she settled. O (1) 1 and BOB G1 and BIS Cox's NL CH Petranella Jersey Boy At Tiroen PDH 4.5 yr l/w dog. This boy was shown in top condition with a well-prepared coat and good featherings, masculine head of good proportions, good length of neck, shoulders are well laid and elbows tidy, ribs well sprung and he showed good strength from the hocks as he moved around the ring, such a sound and powerful mover displaying excellent reach and drive.

AMERICAN COCKER SPANIEL O (1) 1 and BOB Houghton and Le Gresley's Fielgar Flyin The Flag pleasing overall with a good head shape, bright alert eyes and a lovely arch to neck, slightly sloping topline and muscled quarters, moved soundly, would have liked a slightly better spring of rib.

WELSH SPRINGER SPANIEL O (1) 1 and BOB G3 Smith and Ozanne's Islanza Spring Into Action At Lyntonwold, I was very impressed with this one year old bitch, she has a super outline and a well-proportioned head with defined stop and sufficient chiselling under the eyes, low set ears and a kind eye, clean neck into a good lay of shoulder, sufficient forechest for her age but with the time to develop more, good spring of rib and a firm topline held on the move. Very smooth on the out and back displaying good drive in profile, I liked her very much.

CLUMBER SPANIEL O (1) 1 and BOB G2 Heaume's Suelynda Diamonds R' Forever At Francief.

A quite beautiful 2,5 yr b with very good bone and substance, proportionate head with strength to muzzle and well-set ears, clear eyes showing just enough haw, short strong neck and well developed forechest, level topline held on the move. Not surprised to hear she has a CC to her name, one of the nicest I've seen for a long while.

FLAT COATED RETRIEVER O (1) 1 BOB and G4 Spurrier's Kazval All Singin N' Dancin At Dumbleside. What a super bitch this is and at 8 years old one might expect her to start showing sign of age but she's clearly not ready for that yet! So beautifully made all through, lovely head with minimal stop and dark eye, straight forelegs, good ribbing and well-muscled quarters, in profile she absolutely flowed around the ring using her fit condition to advantage, she is however just a little wide in front when coming towards you but I loved her type and her enthusiasm and she deserved her placings today.

COCKER SPANIEL L (2) 1 and BOS Smith and Ozanne's Lyntonwold La Voce Celeste. Very nice in outline with a balanced head and bright eyes holding a keen expression, low set well feathered ears and clean neck, good width and depth to chest, strong in topline and loin, a sound and happy mover. 2 Mauger's Rienmour Dragonfly In Amber, rather overweight and heavy around the shoulders which spoil the overall picture as it made her look short in the neck, holds a good topline when stacked with a good bend of stifle, not quite the animation of the winner on the move. OD (3,1 abs) 1 and BOB De Carteret's Bitcon Spy For Derrindee handsome male with a lovely head and expression, clean slightly arched neck, well boned straight forelegs and good feet, well sprung ribs and a strong topline held on the move. Moved out with animation and total soundness.

2 Smith and Ozanne's Lyntonwold L'Amore Il Signor I liked the overall shape and balance of this dog and he has pleasing head properties with a well-covered frame, not quite as positive on the move as the winner OB (4,2abs) 1 Symphorien's Rienmour Lallybroch Lass attractive b with a feminine head, pleasing intelligent expression and long low set ears, deep through the chest but would have liked a little more forechest, moved out soundly, 2 Symphorien's Jayzander Make A Wish At Rienmour slightly heavier in body than the winner with well sprung ribs and shown in good coat, not as true as the winner on the move.

LABRADOR RETRIEVER O (2) 1 and BOB Sharpe's Kermouster Black Magic 4 yr bitch of good type, attractive head with dark eye and well set ears, neck could be a little cleaner, good lay of shoulder and well sprung ribs, in muscled condition moving out well, just preferred her movement to that of 2. 2 Haynes's Sandylands Fun Time a strong headed dog, well boned all through with a good lay of shoulder and a reasonable length of upper arm, topline dips slightly on the stack but he is carrying just a touch too much weight which didn't help, lovely temperament.

GERMAN WIREHAIRD POINTER P (1) 1 BOB BP, PG1 and RBPIS Far's Germanus Game of Choice, an absolutely cracking 10 mth d, gorgeous head with keen expression and neat well set ears, strong neck, straight forelegs with sufficient forechest for age, deep enough in brisket with tight elbows but not impeding his movement in any way, he holds a level topline stacked and on the move. Shown in excellent condition with a coat of good texture. On the first circuit of the ring he tended to neck in towards his owner looking for treats which spoilt his rear movement but once she stopped baiting him, he went forward beautifully covering the ground with ease. Thrilled to see him win BJIS under my co-judge Rachel Wray

ALASKAN MALAMUTE P (1) 1 and BP, PG1 Brouard's Orsamals Pepe Le Peew 9mth male with a super temperament, head developing nicely with sufficient broadness between the ears, obliquely set eyes and correct bite, straight forelegs down to short strong pasterns, deep enough through the chest for his age with a slightly sloping topline and moderately angulated quarters, once settled he moved away easily with good rear drive O (1) 1 and G2 Brouard's Dreamwolves J'Adore At Orsamals PDH this 4 yr b is very nice in profile, she is well boned with a feminine head and neat well used ears, strong muzzle and good dentition, clean in neck to a moderate lay of shoulder, deep through the

chest with a slightly sloping topline, presented in good coat and condition, a sound mover but could have just a little more drive.

ROTTWEILER P (1) BP and PG2 Clark's Botlierskop Titan Theia 7 mth b of good type, attractive head with sufficient strength for her age, dark eye, correct bite, clean neck into a good lay of shoulder, just a little weak in pasterns currently and not really playing ball on the move. O (2,1abs) 1 and BOB G1 Clark's Botlierskop Scarlet Emerald 3 yr b, very nice in outline and with good bone and substance, head has width to skull, distinct stop and correct bite, clean neck into well laid shoulders, well developed in forechest and deep brisket, firm in topline and well angulated behind with strong parallel hocks, drove out well once she settled.

PASTORAL GROUP

BORDER COLLIE P (1) 1 and BP PG2 Deane's Borderdale Quantum a well grown r/w male in decent coat, strong head with well-set ears but he could use them more. Super topline and croup with moderate hind angulation, well-furnished tail of good length, a free and economical mover LD (1) 1 and BOB Deane's Lesnuages Hermes 2 yr male, a superbly presented and handled 2 yr male, I really liked his head and expression, good use of ears, slightly arched muscular neck straight forelegs and good feet, deep brisket and sufficient forechest, displayed true Border Collie movement. LB (2) 1 Batiste's Tazaeos Knights Florisia an attractive girl with a feminine head and good eye, ample bone and substance, sufficient forechest, she covers the ground freely and easily but tends to fly her tail somewhat which spoils the overall picture. 2 Hitchon and Seward's Lesnuages Phaedra of Patois Tri b, rather more working type but in lovely condition, holds a good topline and carries herself low on the move allowing effortless strides, she does however move rather close behind OD (1) 1 Davies's Foxbarton Kings Noble 3 yr B/w d, pleasing male with a good head, broad skull and ears set well apart, clean neck of moderate length and holds a level topline, I would have liked a little more length to upper arm and this showed in his short front reach (2) 1 Davies's Lesnuages Rosina 2 Martel's Lesnuages Pandora

BSD GROENENDAEL O (1) 1 and BOB G2 Yabsley's Jetaime Higher Love**, such a beautifully presented 20 mth d of superb temperament, blunt wedge head with muzzle of medium length, dark bright eyes, high set and well used ears, stands on well boned legs and strong patterns, body almost square with a deep chest and well-muscled quarters, a free and brisk mover, liked him very much. Was thrilled to see him win Best Yearling In Show under Rachel Wray.

ROUGH COLLIE O (2,abs)

BEARDED COLLIE O (1) 1 and BOB Martel's Jupiter De Chester Avec Majikcharms PDH 4 yr dog in great coat, skull is broad and flat with proportionate muzzle and moderate stop, I liked his shape and balance and he is well ribbed with a good topline and is balanced in front and rear angulation, moved out smoothly holding his topline, however I would have liked a little more weight and body condition on him which cost him a place in the Group.

GSD L (2) 1 and BOB G1 and RBIS Lawrence's Chalkville Brigadier, what an absolute cracker this 12 mth dog is, I liked his type and overall shape good head with well-used ears and correct bite, strong neck, well laid shoulders, well boned forelegs and flexible patterns, level in topline with short slightly sloping croup and strong hocks, he gaited out smoothly covering the ground with ease. Was delighted to see him win RB Junior In Show Under Rachel Wray 2 Brache's Chalkville Ambassador , brother of the winner and of larger frame all over, he too has a generally good shape and is well boned, but he is rather deep through the body making him look a little heavy but he has a good topline, a little restricted in movement to begin with but in the later classes as the handler gained confidence he moved out really well .

SHETLAND SHEEPDOG P [2] 1 and BP Le Poidevin's Philhope Full Diva Very much a baby but an exceedingly pretty girl with a beautiful expression and well used ears, straight forelegs and a good topline, moved out with confidence, she is just a little over-angulated in the rear which may correct itself somewhat as she matures on 2 Le Gallez's Annakarose Spirit Of Arkle taller than the winner and not quite so confident on the move, when encouraged to use her ears she has the sweetest expression, she just needs time and some sympathetic handling but all the essentials are there. {O} 1 and BOB Le Poidevi's' Conorvean Bobbin Joan what a lovely specimen this 8 yr bitch is, super make and shape with a lovely head and sweet expression, her good use of ears enhancing this nicely, straight forelegs, coat rises slightly over the loin, strong parallel hocks, a smart and sound mover.

POLISH LOWLAND SHEEPDOG L [1] 1 and BOB Dowding's Mybeards Hattie a very nice b with a proportionate head and a kind eye, compact in body with deep chest and a good lay of shoulder, strong slightly sloping pasterns, flat topline and short croup, moved away smoothly with a sound easy gait O [1] 1 Dowding's Mybeards Golden Button 9 year b and a credit to her owner, in super shape and coat and such a willing showgirl, I just preferred the rear movement of the limit winner.
