PUPPY CLASS

1ST BPIM German Shepherd "Chalsksville Magnum Force" Owned by Barbara Lawrence

Dark black and gold of medium size with a lovely head and expression. Good front assembly, correct backline, good feet. Moved very well, showed good hind thrust and far reaching forward. **I also awarded this puppy Runner up in Match**

2nd RBPIM Rhodesian Ridgeback "Tukela Ayana" Owned by Debbie Torode

A light coloured red, lovely outgoing temperament has a good depth and balanced angulation, good bone and tidy nicely balanced ridge, steady movement.

3rd Cocker Spaniel "Kyna Florence at Rienmour" Owned by Lynne Symphorien

Pleasing head and expression.

JUNIOR CLASS

1ST BJIM Chinese Crested "Prajna Calling the Tune At Lyntonridge" Owned by Mrs L Ozanne

Hairless bitch white and black, good head and eye, shoulder had lovely supple skin. Moved well like a show pony.

2nd Hungarian Wire haired Vizla "Zoldami Disco" Owned by Rachel Martel

Well-made dog, pleasing head with kind eye and expression. Strong neck and top line, moved freely, would have like to see more thrust behind when he moved.

3rd Rhodesian Ridgeback "Zejack Kooior" Owned by Graham Glass

Tall upright, Red brown dog moved very well but needs to mature a bit.

YEARLING

1st Cocker Spaniel "Jaysander Make a Wish at Rienmour" Owned by Lynne Symphorien

Lovely head and expression, strong reaching neck, well placed shoulders with correct return of upper arm. Nicely assembled hind angulation and muscle tone throughout, she moved effortlessly with drive and style.

2nd Hungarian Vizla "Owned by J. Smith

Well made, good bone and substance. Pleasing head, kind eyes, strong neck and top line, her underline was slightly too pronounced, well-muscled which enabled her to be able to move freely.

Adult Winners class 6

1st Shih Tzu "Miracey Seriously Spicey" Owned by Sammie Bowring

A sweet solid red brown dog, good masculine head with soft expression, lovely dark eyes, good dentition, strong well balanced movement, good turn of stifle, tail carried good.

2nd Tibetan Terrier "Lansang Tiger Lily" Owned by C. Le Moignan

A blue coloured square in profile very well made offering everything in the correct place, shown in coat of correct texture, shame to meet my previous winner.

3rd Shih Tzu "Forepaws Gift of Gold" Owned by Jean Girard

Gold and white presented beautifully, nice wide head, moved well showing full pad also well-muscled.

Adult Winners class 7

1st Cocker Spaniel "Lyntonwold Lallique" Owned by Pam Smith

Lovely Blue Roan bitch beautiful head, well laid back shoulders, short and compact body, lovely quarters in beautiful coat, moved very well.

2nd Rhodesian Ridgeback "Owned by Debbie Torode

Strong bitch, strong and great bone, presented a picture of strength, good from and spring of rib, correct ridge, moved out well.

3rd Hungarian Visla "Cherrybower Abbey Road" Owned by S. McCarthy

Lovely expression, medium sized and well proportioned, correct animated movement, would have like it to stand over more ground.

GROUP WINNERS
