Elegant neck leading to well placed shoulders. Body developing well for age. Moved soundly with steady stride. Terrier Puppy Group 1

Handsome dog with excellent head and eye. Alert to his handler's every wish. Sturdy construction with good spring of rib. Well developed rear assembly. Moved out with drive. Presented in mint condition. BOB & Terrier Group 2

OPEN DOG (2,0a)

1<sup>st</sup> Fletcher & Seedhouse's GRANITANGEL ZIRCON

Handsome lad with pleasing head. Nothing overdone. Keen expression. Well muscled neck and correct shoulders. Level topline & well sprung ribs. When viewed from behind, legs were correctly placed. Very businesslike and precise in his movement. Makes a great picture. BOB & Terrier Group 4

- OPEN BITCH (2,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Fletcher & Seedhouse's GRANITANGEL ROUGH DIAMOND  
 Pretty bitch with correct headpiece and well placed ears. Correct dentition. Strong neck and correct lay of shoulder. Plenty of substance with level topline. Movement was free flowing with drive. Preferred the head of the dog, but I was splitting hairs in my decision.  
 2<sup>nd</sup> Fletcher & Seedhouse's GRANITANGEL SOLAR FLARE
- WHWT PUPPY (1,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Pinto's MCKALAY JACK IN THE BOX  
 Attractive dog with plenty of spirit. Enjoyed his day. Compact body with level topline and correct tail carriage. Well boned. Coat coming on nicely. Needs to firm up a touch in rear, but this will come with time. Moved out with style. Terrier Puppy Group 2
- OPEN (2,1a) 1<sup>st</sup> Pinto's MCKALAY DOES YOUR MOTHER KNOW  
 Lovely bitch with much to like about her. Very pretty head and correct earset. Sparkling, keen expression. Cobby body and correct tailset. Good bone and muscle tone. Moved with drive and style. Very well presented. BOB & Terrier Group 3
- AVNSC TERRIER OPEN (1,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Smith's Glen of Imaal, ROMAINVILLE BODHRAN

 Super make & shape. Correct length to muzzle and dark eye. Level topline. Excellent bone & muscle. Coat in excellent condition. BOB & Hound Group 4
- MWH DACHSHUND LIMIT (1,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Sebire's COFFEE COOKIE AT BOUVEE  
 Delightful bitch with pleasing head & eye. Good length of neck and well placed shoulders. Level topline. Very sound. Loved her attitude to the whole affair. BOB
- SALUKI LIMIT (1,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Marshall's DACFOLKE ALEXANDRITE  
 This young dog was elegant & so well put together. Just a tad shy at first but later on came to me with more confidence. I liked him a lot. Beautiful head, long and narrow with dark pigment. Viewed from the side has classic profile. Strong topline and good sweep of stifle. Movement tends to be a little erratic at times but he is only a youngster. With his clever and patient handler this will improve I am sure. Will wait his development with interest. BOB

A well grown baby with plenty of substance. Well proportioned and balanced throughout. Very pleasing broad head and keen expression. Sound mover, keeping topline on the move. Best Puppy.

Pretty nine month bitch with delightful temperament. Well constructed with good proportions. Pleasing in head and eye. Sound, steady mover with excellent feet and front.

Substantial dog. Balanced throughout. Effortless movement demonstrating just how well he is put together. Excellent front and rear assemblies. In beautiful condition. BOB & Hound Group 3

A little shy at first but soon settled. Time and patience will pay dividends for this most attractive bitch. Melting expression and kind eye. Long neck and correct shoulders. Pleasing outline and although movement was hard to assess, she did do a triangle with positive stride. She just needs more confidence.

Very feminine head and expression. Ample length of neck. Well boned and ribbed. Moved with drive from excellent rear assembly. Coat in good condition. BOB

LABRADOR RETRIEVER  
PUPPY (2,1a)

1<sup>st</sup> Baudains' BEAUVOIR PICTURE PERFECT

Substantial lad with good head. Nothing overdone. Intelligent, keen expression. Best of fronts and well ribbed body. Good turn of stifle and well developed rear assembly for a youngster. Sound, stylish mover. Gundog Puppy Group 2

OPEN DOG (2,1a)

1<sup>st</sup> Haynes' TALEEM SPIRIT OF SARK

I liked this dog very much. Classic head and kind eye. Well placed ears. Ample neck and well laid shoulders. Substantial body. Good front and rear. Well off for bone. Moved out with purpose and drive. BOB & Gundog Group 4

1<sup>st</sup> Baudains' JANCERIE COUNTRY CARAMEL AT BEAUVOIR

Good head, front and body. Would have preferred slightly darker eye. Substantial overall, although a little short on the leg for me. Sound mover. Covered the ground well.

1<sup>st</sup> Ozanne's Spanish Water Dog, HOLLUTRIX YEMOMI DEL  
LYNTONRIDGE

Soundly constructed and typical specimen of the breed. Compact and in great condition. Appealing head shape and intelligent eye. Wide open nostrils. Level back. Superb coat quality. Sound, brisk movement. Best AVNSC Gundog Puppy & Gundog Puppy Group 1

2<sup>nd</sup> Baudains' English Setter, CANONSETT DEJA VU AT BEAUVOIR
