#### **WORKING GROUP**

Alaskan Malamute. Open (2,1a) 1st Brouard's Dreamwolves J'Adore At Orsamals.A powerhouse on the move, this bitch was enjoying her day. Overall picture was of a balanced and co-ordinated example of the breed. She has a pleasing head shape, not overdone any way and keen expression. Strong in body with well muscled rear assembly, enabling her to move out with drive. Compact feet, Sound throughout & in tip top condition. BOB, Group 1 & BIS 3. Rottweiler. Open (2,0a) 1st Brouard's Botlierskop Heaven Sent. This mature bitch has a pleasing head of correct proportions. Keen expression & clean dentition. Sound in body with well laid shoulders. Plenty of substance and bone. Movement was precise and co-ordinated. A pleasure to go over. BOB & G3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Clark's Botlierskop Scarlet Emerald. Another with head of correct proportions and good dentition. Pleasing in overall balance and in excellent condition. Gave her handler a hard time and not guite as settled as winner on the move. **Boxer.** Open (2,1a) 1st Bayes MBE Docrema Don Giovanni. Typical head with broad muzzle. Dark eye and correct undershot dentition. Not as compact in body as I would like. Ample bone and tight feet. Excellent condition. BOB & G4. Import Register (Limit & Open) (1,0a) 1st Sharrock's Entlebucher Mountain Dog, Edison-Eiger Vom Rickental. The Standard for this breed is somewhat daunting but when this dog entered the ring everything fell into place. He fits the Standard completely. Medium size with handsome head, flat skull and strong muzzle. Clean scissor bite. Kindly alert expression. Body is of correct length being longer than tall (10 – 8 ratio), with strong rear assembly enabling a precise co-ordinated movement. A pleasure to judge and will watch his show career with interest. Hope to see him on the mainland. Best Import Register and G2. **AV Open Bitch** (5,2a) 1<sup>st</sup> Dreamwolves J'Adore At Orsamals. 2<sup>nd</sup> Botlierskop Heaven Sent. 3<sup>rd</sup> Botlierskop Scarlet Emerald. AV Breeders Open (3,1a) 1st Botlierskop Scarlet Emerald. 2nd Bayes MBE Docrema Don Giovanni. *AV Veteran* (2,1a) 1<sup>st</sup> Clark's Rottweiler Botlierskop Viognier. Well balanced bitch with large head of correct proportions. Keen alert expression and correct clean dentition. Strong body with well laid shoulders and so well off for bone and muscle. Reserve Best Veteran in Show.g Pastoral Group

**Australian Shepherd** Puppy (1,0a) 1st Turner's Tanmark's Peter Pan. Stood alone with great ring presence. Broad balanced head with correct eye colour and black nose. Well developed in muscle and bone. Powerful rear assembly enabling him to move with drive and precision. Coat coming on well. BOB, Best Puppy in Breed, and Best Puppy in Group. **Bearded Collie.** Open (1,0a) 1st Martel's Jupiter De Chester Avec Majikcharms PDH. Pleasing head with broad flat and square skull. Strength in muzzle with correct dentition. Ample neck leading to well placed shoulders. Sound throughout with plenty of heart and lung room. On the move he was relaxed and covered the ground with ease. BOB & G3. **German Shepherd Dog.** Open (1,0a). 1st Lawrence's Jsy Ch Surfstone Hot Salsa PDH. This dog is so special he commands attention. Great style and enthusiasm. Correct proportions to head and correct

earset. Alert keen expression. Good length of back and strong, broad powerful rear assembly enabling him to really stride out. He covers the ground with ease and style. Superb temperament, Presented in immaculate coat and condition, BOB, G1 and BIS 4. Shetland Sheepdog. Open (1,0a) 1st Le Poidevin's Conorvean Bobbin Joan. Pretty headed bitch who showed herself well. Alert with gentle disposition. Correct clean dentition. Sound in body with level topline. Her movement was precise and graceful. Presented in immaculate coat and condition. BOB, G4 and Best AV Pastoral Veteran. *Polish Lowland Sheepdog.* Limit (1,0a) 1st Dowding's Mybeards Hattie. Head of pleasing proportions. Intelligent expression and correct dentition. Strong neck, well laid shoulders and level topline. Well off for bone & muscle. On the move gave a good account of herself, benefitting from the large ring. Excellent condition. Open (1,0a) 1st Dowding's Mybeards Golden Buttons. Same remarks apply as for Limit winner with the exception of showmanship. She really pulled out all the stops as a class act. I just loved her enthusiasm for the whole affair. BOB. Border Collie. Limit Dog (1,0a) 1st Deane's Lesnuages Hermes. Balanced dog with pleasing head and alert intelligent expression. Correct dentition. Good reach of neck and lay of shoulder. Well developed rear enabled him to move out with positive sound movement. Limit Bitch (2,0a) 1st Baptiste's Tazaeous Knights Florisia. A happy bitch enjoying her day. Pleasing head shape and well carried erect ears. Intelligent alert expression. Strong bone and well muscled. Sound throughout with precise movement but just a touch close behind. 2<sup>nd</sup> Hitchon & Seward's Lesnuages Phaedra Of Patois. A pretty bitch who unfortunately was disinclined to show of her best. Pleasing head shape and correct dentition. Well laid shoulders and excellent bone. She would not use her tail and it rather spoilt the overall picture when on the move. Open Dog (1,0a) 1st Davies' Foxbarton Kings Noble. Quality dog who pleased me greatly. Classic headpiece with ears carried erect. Correct clean dentition. Excellent reach of neck leading to correct lay of shoulder. On the move he showed just how well he is put together. Positive and co-ordinated action on tight feet and using his tail to full effect. Presented in glorious coat and condition. BOB & G2. Open Bitch (3.1a) 1st Hitchon & Seward's Patois Phizz. Pretty bitch with classic head shape and earset. Well off for bone and muscle tone. Intelligent expression and clean dentition. Carried herself well with enthusiasm. Just a tad close behind. Lovely coat and condition. 2<sup>nd</sup> Batiste's Tazaeous Knights Florisia. *Belgian Shepherd Dog* (Groenendael) Puppy (1,0a) 1st Yabsley's Jetaime Higher Love. This young dog has a deal of confidence and was a pleasure to go over. Skull shape developing well, flat and with a length of muzzle correct at this age. Ears carried erect. Neck of good length and well laid back shoulders. Powerful rear assembly with well placed hocks and tight feet. Sound throughout. Excellent coat and condition. Best Puppy & BOB. Rough Collie. Puppy (1,0a) 1st Roberts' Barrenclough Band Of Gold. Delightful youngster at his first show. Smart appearance, well coated and with outgoing personality. Pleasing head, black nose and correct dentition. Attentive at all times with an enquiring expression. Firm body. Well ribbed with quality bone and well let down hocks. Precise and co-ordinated movement. This dog has a bright future. Best Puppy, BOB, Puppy Group 1 and 3rd Best Puppy in Show. AV Pastoral. Puppy (2,0a) 1st Turner's Tanmark's Peter Pan. 2nd Yabsley's Jetaime Higher Love. Junior (2,0a) 1st Deane's Lesnuages Hermes. 2nd Yabsley's Jetaime Higher Love. Good lay of shoulder leading to spirit level topline. Fine bone. Her skin was clear, supple and well cared for. Sound positive movement. Pleased to award her BOB and Toy Group 1. BIS 6. Cavalier KC Spaniel Limit (1,0a) 1st Bennett's Honeybet Happy Talk. Handsome dog with pleasing head. Large dark sparkling eyes. Correct dentition. Good shoulder placement and level back. Rear assembly well boned with good turn of stifle. Sound throughout with excellent coat and condition. BOB & Toy Group 4. Pug. Open (1,0a) 1st Symphorien's Regencylodge Roxelle At Rienmour. This three year old bitch was a joy to go over. Best of heads with plenty of work in it. Compact body and high set tail. Balanced throughout and on the move displayed a correct precise smart action. She was enjoying her day and it showed in her zeal for the job in hand. Beautiful coat and condition. BOB & Toy Group 2. *Papillon*. Open Dog (2,0a) 1st Simon & Smith's Garsiv's Sunny Of Ringlands. Head of correct proportions with well placed flaring ears. Medium length of neck but shoulders a tad upright. Quality coat in good condition. Purposeful movement. BOB. 2<sup>nd</sup> Simon & Smith's Ringlands Tango In The Heat. Pleasing head and sweetest of natures, this dog has a problem with his movement, caused by incorrect front and shoulders. When he moves he displays and incorrect topline. Open Bitch (2, 0a) 1st Simon & Smith's Ringlands Frosted Fern. Pretty head with large well fringed ears. Soft expression and dark eye. Well off for bone and good feet. Coat in excellent condition. Moved out with some style. 2<sup>nd</sup> Cooper's Ch Omegaville Make Me A Petit Chein. Sweet six year old in very fair condition. Well presented. Good shape to skull and clean dentition. On the move was not guite as fluid as winner but none the less a very creditable performance. Chihuahua LC. Puppy (1,0a) 1st Bunce & Sarre's Dancing Beauty. A beautiful bitch who at 9 months will eventually trouble the best for top honours. Classic head with superb apple dome and good stop. Large flaring ears frame an appealing expression. Excellent lay back of shoulder and level topline. Correct turn of stifle and neat feet. Brisk precise movement and a super coat completed the picture. I just loved her. BOB and delighted to see her go Best Puppy in Show. Limit (1,0a) 1st Bunce & Sarre's Dancing Beauty. Australian Silky Terrier. Open (1,0a) 1st Walker's Brookemur Chasin Pavements At Petwalk. Businesslike young dog with compact body. Keen expression and dark eye. Well laid shoulders and correct topline. Well developed rear assembly with excellent turn of stifle. Small neat feet. His whole make up is one of quality & style. Presented in mint condition. BOB & Toy Group 3. **AV Toy.** Puppy (1,0a) 1st Bunce & Sarre's Dancing Beauty. Junior (1,0a) 1st Bunce & Sarre's Dancing Beauty, Yearling (2.0a) 1st Bennett's Honeybet Happy Talk, 2nd Ozanne's Prajna Moment In Time at Lyntonridge. Open Dog (3,1a) 1st Simon & Smith's Garsiv's Sunny Of Ringlands. 2<sup>nd</sup> Simon & Smith's Ringlands Tango In The

None the less he has a pleasing head and correct dentition. Enough bone and substance, he moved out with good drive. Open Bitch (2,0a) 1st Walker's Multi Ch Petwalk Irresistible. Beautiful bitch who fits the standard completely. Ample head furnishings, falling correctly. Clean dentition. Strong balanced and compact body with well muscled rear assembly. Free flowing movement showed how well she is put together. Glorious coat and condition. She made a stunning overall picture. BOB & Group 2. 2nd Billington's Dancing Lady at Denzarnia. Sweet bitch in very fair overall condition. Good skull shape and alert eve. Not quite the mover of winner but provided a satisfactory performance. *Tibetan* Terrier. Limit (1,0a) 1st Wyser's Majikcharms Mr Casanova. Pleasing dog with well placed ears and large dark eyes. Ample neck and well laid shoulders. Square in shape overall with plenty of bone and substance. Sound steady movement. Excellent coat and condition. Open Dog. (3,1a) 1st Le Moignan's Waterley Skyfall PDH. Superb headpiece of correct proportions. Well furnished. Dark eyes and clean dentition. Strong neck with well laid shoulders. Plenty of substance and strong rear assembly. Sound positive movement on large round feet. Superb coat and condition. BOB. 2<sup>nd</sup> Martel's Majikcharms U R The One. Two year old who really enjoyed his day. Alert to his handlers every need. Good balance and positive driving action. Not guite the showman as winner but a very steady gentleman. French Bulldog. Limit (2,0a) 1st Breban's Chamelia Salted Caramel. Well balanced dog with well placed ears and intelligent expression. Sturdy body and well muscled rear assembly. A real showman in good stride and co-ordinated action. Superb condition. BOB & Group 3. 2<sup>nd</sup> Deane's Kenguince I Wish. Substantial dog in good condition. Appealing expression and alert attitude. Not as smooth in movement as winner, but good overall performance. **Shih Tzu.** Puppy Dog (1,0a) 1<sup>st</sup> Cooper's Forepaws Flash Gordon. Young dog whose head is developing well. Good skull shape with large ears and dark round eyes. Sturdy body with strong bone. Needs to tighten up but has plenty of time. Also needs to settle on the move, but given time this lad will do well. Superb temperament. Best Puppy in Breed and BPIS 4. Puppy Bitch (2,0a) 1st Robilliard's Cavateena Vazon Sandy Shore. Pretty bitch. Smart and purposeful on the move. At 9 months shows promise. Broad head developing well. Dark expressive eyes. Satisfactory reach of neck with well laid shoulders. Well off for bone. Sound steady movement and perfectly groomed.2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon's Cavateena Belgrave Red Bay. Pleasing body shape and presentation but just could not match the movement of winner. Limit Dog (2,0a) 1st De La Cour's Santosha Only After Eight. Pleasing head shape with well placed ears. Correct dentition. Firm body with good bone and muscle. Sound throughout with a positive movement enabling him to power around the ring. Immaculate presentation. 2<sup>nd</sup> De La Cour's Santosha Polar Star. I would have like more in head properties. Similar in build and outline as winner just not finished. Movement quite satisfactory. Limit Bitch (2,0a) 1st De La Cour's Cavateena

Whispering Sands. I loved this delightful lady. Pretty head with correct large ears. Well laid shoulders and firm level topline. She is well off for bone and has well padded feet. Movement was positive, covering the ground with ease and style. Beautiful coat in mint condition completed the picture. BOB & Group 4. 2<sup>nd</sup> Cooper's Forepaws Style In Motion. Sweet bitch in excellent condition. Good skull shape and alert expression. Fair balance throughout. Not the positivity of action as winner. Open Dog. (3,2a) 1st De La Cour's Santosha Sandy Cove. Sturdy dog with masculine head and large dark eyes. Satisfactory body with level topline. Moved soundly on firm feet. Presentation could be improved. Open Bitch (1,0a) Cooper's Forepaws Joi De Vivre. Bitch of sweetest disposition. Classic head shape and clear dark eves. Well off for bone and muscle. Coat a tad untidy for me. Sound mover. Toy Poodle. (1,0a) 1st Smithers' Tuttlebees In The Limelight At Meantmore. Chocolate dog with appealing head. Refined back skull and dark pigment. Compact body with excellent tail carriage. Balanced overall with real attitude, he made a pleasing picture with a brisk precise movement. Put down to the minute. A real showman. BOB. Standard Poodle. Open (1,0a) 1st Jsy Ch Chalkwell Who's That Girl At Meantmore. This fabulous white bitch was a joy to go over. Full of quality and breed type. Balanced throughout with superb outline. Feminine head and expressive eyes. Well laid shoulders and correct reach of neck. Her movement was spot on, as she powered round the ring making a striking picture. Fabulous preparation and presentation. I wish she were mine. BOB & Group 1, I was delighted to see her go Reserve BIS to great applause. *Miniature Schnauzer*. Puppy (1,0a) 1st Kennedy-Cook's Lottie Northern Princess. This youngster has a fair way to go yet. Head is developing well for age. Moderate neck but shoulders a tad upright. Coat not yet of correct texture. Moved out quite well. BOB. AV Utility. Puppy (3,0a) 1st Robilliard's Cavateena Vazon Sandy Shore. 2<sup>nd</sup> Gordon's Cavateena Belgrave Red Bay. 3<sup>rd</sup> Kennedy-Cook's Lottie Northern Princess. Junior (6,1a) 1st Walker & Journeaux's Petwalk Creme De La Creme.2<sup>nd</sup> Smithers' Tuttlebees In The Limelight At Meantmore. 3rd Robilliard's Cavateena Vazon Sandy Shore.
