Efficiency, kindness and the most generous of hospitality are the hallmarks of this club and it was a real thrill to be invited back here again after three years. The venue is superb: spacious with excellent lighting and large green carpeted rings. I was most impressed with the hard muscular condition with the vast majority of exhibits, allowing them to make the best of their potential.

BIS the glorious **GSD, Penwartha Apache Arrow**, and **RBIS** the powerfully built **Boxer, Docrema My Boy Madge. BPIS & 3rd BIS Tibetan Terrier, Kybo Mister Milan at Kaladash** and **RBPIS Pomeranian, Rudoli Tantalizer. BVIS Cocker Spaniel, Salabah Sorceress**, ultra typical blue roan with excellent bone, shoulder, hindleg, forechest and feet, making light of her almost 10 years. She moved to match the excellence of her confirmation. **Best Brace in Show**, Lawrence's glorious GSDS with **Best Team** going to Le Page's typey blue roan Cocker: the BV mother and her two charming daughters.

PUPPY (2e, 1ab)

1. Morgan & Simmons' Kybo Mister Milan at Kaladash. Super black dog, who holds himself so proudly, chock full of breed type and so well balanced with excellent topline, tailset and carriage, beautifully presented in very good coat for his age. Lovely head, dark expressive eye, decent shoulder and so well conformed all through, this being reflected in his sound energetic movement with good reach in profile. A charming friendly character, full of typical puppy bounce and enthusiasm. Most exciting. I gathered later that he is litter brother to K Tarabella, who at six months won a well filled PB class under me at Border Union so it would seem there is some good breeding going on here. **BP, BOB, G1, PG1, BPIS & BIS3**

Super sound and brisk on the move. A great showman, just not in the fullest of coat currently. **BOB & G2**

1. Bayes' Docrema My Boy Madge. Most impressive and masculine with, my notes say "simply everything right" Beautiful head and eye, well balanced with good layback of shoulder and hind angulation with short straight back and deep chest. So strong and squarely built, in the most superb coat and hard muscular condition. Great showman, who was a joy to both handle and watch on the move, driving from his hocks and covering ground in profile. He certainly has the wow factor in profusion.
